

2010 CONVENTION ENRICHMENT SESSIONS

SESSION A THE HONORABLE SCOTT BRISTER – “FOR THE AUTHORITIES ARE MINISTERS OF GOD” Paul encouraged the Christians living in the capital city of a pagan and often oppressive empire to be subject to the governing authorities, “for they are ministers of God.” (Romans 13:1-7) Reflecting on his 20 years of service as a judge, including 6 years on the Texas Supreme Court, former Justice Scott Brister will address some of the conflicts he encountered and lessons he learned in government service and politics. The session will also cover the Christian foundations of the jury system, and lessons from Biblical law that still have interesting applications for today.

SESSION B MELODY ROSENWINKEL – “MORMONISM: WHAT IS IT? LIVING IN IT, LIVING WITH IT” Having grown up in the Mormon Church before becoming a Christian, Melody offers life experiences and vital information on ways Christians can reach out to Mormons.

SESSION C JAN WENDORF – “WITH HIS MELODY IN MY HEART” Do you ever find yourself humming a tune all day long? Perhaps it's a jingle from a commercial, or a song you heard, or a favorite hymn. God's love letter to you –His Word– is filled with “music” for your daily walk. Learn and share methods for intentional study of the Word in an interactive setting as Lutheran Women in Mission who are in the Word, of the Word and walking with the Lord, the Word made flesh.

SESSION D LINDA REISER – “GET TO OR GOT TO?” Together we will look at David's three-fold process of praise from Psalm 34, review our own attitude, its importance, and share some attitude applications.

SESSION E DR. TOM CEDEL – “DEVELOPING YOUNG CHRISTIAN LEADERS” How can we help develop young Christian leaders within our churches, schools and families? This session looks at Christ's model for developing the disciples as leaders as well as the role both horizontal and vertical generational connections play in leadership development.

SESSION F PASTOR MARK SEEGER – “REACHING THAT ISOLATED DEAF CHILD” There are deaf children scattered all over the map and these deaf children need the Gospel as much as any hearing child. This session will help the participants get some ideas how to reach the deaf child living in their towns.

SESSION G JOHN GOEKE – “SAME SEX ATTRACTION - IS IT SOMEONE ELSE'S PROBLEM?” How does a Christian family act and react to the news that a member of the family claims to be “gay”? Witness the power of Jesus in this true family story.

SESSION H LORRI HACKETT & BRUCE WURDEMAN – “WOMEN'S ROLE IN LUTHERAN HOUR MINISTRIES' MEN'S NETWORK” It's called the Men's Network, but that doesn't mean women can't be an important part in the process of getting men involved. This presentation revolves around a woman's need to understand the LHM's Men's Network and support the men in her life in using these resources to become a better role model within the family, congregation, and community. Join Bruce and Lorri as they examine both sides of the “he said, she said” story in this fact filled, yet humorous approach to the Men's Network.

SESSION I BERVIN MIRTSCHING – “CATALYST: LUTHERAN HOUR MINISTRIES” Amidst the deluge of information, misinformation, and disinformation in this “Information Age”, more people than ever need to hear the eternal truth in the salvation story of Jesus. It has never been more important for Christians to focus on the mission to which we are called.

SESSION J SARAH GULDALIAN – “EQUIPPING TO SHARE: LUTHERAN HOUR MINISTRIES” It is no coincidence that God has put you in this very place, at this exact time, with this specific person. In fact ,it's a mission moment, ordained by God, for you to share the message of His Son, Jesus Christ. But how? EQUIPPING TO SHARE helps get you ready for witnessing with insights from Scripture, real-life witnessing experience, and practical exercises - all with a great deal of interaction, heart, and humor. Join Sarah in this instructional workshop to learn easy and practical ways of sharing your faith without delay.

SESSION K ELOISE KUHLMANN & DIANN HIGGINS – “MINISTRY, MISSION AND VISION: TOOLS FOR YOUR SOCIETIES” This session deals finding ways to increase membership and spiritual growth in our LWML Societies.

SESSION L FRIENDS INTO SERVING HIM® FACILITATORS – “TEEN LWML” Discover practical ways to get teenagers involved in Teen LWML and local LWML Societies.
